

Guide to Completing CBSA Form E29B for Returning a Rented Aircraft Scale to the US

As a Canadian customer, you're responsible for managing the CBSA Form E29B to export a rented aircraft scale back to the US. This form, used for temporary imports, must be presented at the border to acquit the importation and release any security deposit. Below are the steps to verify and use the form, along with a sample to illustrate how it should look based on typical aircraft scale details.

Steps to Complete and Use Form E29B for Export

1. Locate the Original Form E29B

- Find the Form E29B issued when the scale entered Canada (provided by CBSA or your customs broker). This document lists the scale's details, import date, and any security posted (e.g., bond or cash deposit equal to potential duties/taxes).
- If you don't have it, contact CBSA (1-800-461-9999) with the original entry number or consult your broker.
- **Tip:** Ensure the form's details (e.g., serial number) match the scale being returned.

3. Verify Key Fields on the Form

- Check that the form accurately describes the scale. Key fields include:
 - **Importer Information:** Your company name, address, and contact details.
 - **Goods Description:** Detailed info, e.g., "Aircraft weighing scale, Model XYZ, Serial #12345, made in USA."
 - **Value:** Full replacement value of the scale (e.g., \$10,000 USD), not just the rental fee.
 - **Temporary Import Conditions:** Notes the scale was for temporary use (e.g., "Rental for aircraft weighing, to be exported within 2 years").
 - **Security Details:** Records any bond or deposit posted.
- If corrections are needed (e.g., wrong serial number), contact CBSA before export.

4. Prepare Supporting Documents

- Gather these to present with the E29B at the border:
 - **Original commercial invoice** from when the scale entered Canada (provided by the U.S. shipper), showing description, value, and U.S. origin.
 - **Return commercial invoice** (ask the U.S. shipper for this), stating "American Goods Returned after temporary rental – No advancement in value – HTSUS 9801.00.10."
 - **Bill of Lading (BOL)** from your carrier, detailing the shipment to the US.
 - **Proof of U.S. Origin:** E.g., manufacturer's declaration or export records from the U.S. shipper.
- **Tip:** Ensure serial numbers match across all documents to avoid inspection delays.

5. Present Form E29B at the CBSA Border Crossing

- Take the scale to a CBSA border crossing (e.g., a highway port like Peace Bridge). The driver or your broker presents:

- The original or a copy of Form E29B.
 - Supporting documents (invoices, BOL).
 - The physical scale for inspection, if requested.
 - CBSA verifies the scale matches the E29B, confirms it hasn't been modified (beyond normal wear), and stamps the form to acquit the temporary import. This releases any security deposit.
 - **Time:** Allow 1-2 hours; avoid peak border times.
 - **Tip:** Use a carrier experienced in cross-border shipments for aircraft equipment.
6. **Coordinate with U.S. Shipper for Re-Entry**
- After CBSA clearance, the scale crosses into the US. Provide the U.S. shipper with a copy of the stamped E29B to support their CBP Form 3311 (Declaration for Free Entry of Returned American Products). This isn't your responsibility but helps ensure a smooth handoff.
 - **Note:** No new E29B is filled out for export; you're only presenting the original.
7. **Keep Records**
- Retain the stamped E29B and all documents for at least 3 years (CBSA requirement). If a security deposit was posted, follow up with CBSA or your broker to confirm its release.
